Hunting adventures from coast to coast

Quebec City, December 14, 2015 – The Canadian Federation of Outfitter Associations (CFOA) is proud to offer two unique adventure packages at the 2016 Safari Club International Convention, taking place in Las Vegas this coming February.

The *Great Canadian Adventure* consists of hunting trips in four different Canadian provinces and territories, to be auctioned as a single item. This allows the winning bidder to visit a wide variety of landscapes and hunting grounds located along some of the nicest rivers in Canada. This package will be auctioned off during the evening auctions on Thursday, February 4th. Online bidding is available for SCI members.

THE GREAT CANADIAN ADVENTURE 2016 INCLUDES:

- 1) A moose and black bear combo hunting trip in Newfoundland & Labrador, with [Arluk Outfitters](#);
- 2) A caribou hunt in Northern Quebec, with [Leaf River Lodge](#);
- 3) A goose hunt on the coasts of Hudson Bay, in Manitoba, with [Webber's Lodges](#);
- 4) An elk and deer combo hunting trip in British Columbia, with [Kettle River Outfitters](#).

The second package consists of a 10-day, one-on-one guided Yukon/Alaska moose hunt, for one hunter and one observer, and is offered by [MacMillan River Adventures](#). This package will be sold during the day auctions.

All adventures are provided by some of the most reputable outfitters in Canada. These trips can be taken in 2016 or 2017 (check with individual outfitter for more information). All hunts are transferable. More details are provided on CFOA's website: www.canadianoutfitters.org.

By offering these adventures, CFOA intends to promote Canada as a unique destination for hunters from all over the world, as much for the number of different species found here as by the variety of landscape in this country.
